Primary School



STEP 2: INITIAL ASSESSMENT WITH PARENT/CARER

The practitioner speaks with the parent/carer to discuss the referral and obtain parent consent before the intervention can begin.



STEP 4: SESSIONS BEGIN

We typically offer 8 sessions. Sessions are continually reviewed to ensure the young person, parent or carer is engaging and benefiting from the support provided.



STEP 6: ENDING ASSESSMENT & CLOSE

For counselling, a final check in with take place with the parent. Signposting for future support may also be discussed.

Once the final session is completed, an ending letter can be sent out to both the parent and referrer.

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STEP 1: REFERRAL RECEIVED

A referral is made. This could be a self-referral or made by a member of staff. The referral is then processed by our admin team, who review the referral form and check suitability for the service.

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STEP 3: INITIAL ASSESSMENT WITH YOUNG PERSON

For counselling a meet and greet session takes place between the counsellor and the young person to introduce themselves and the service, giving the young person the opportunity to give consent.
