

# OFF THE RECORD'S SCHOOLS TEAM REFERRAL PATHWAY

## Secondary School



### STEP 2: INITIAL ASSESSMENT WITH YOUNG PERSON

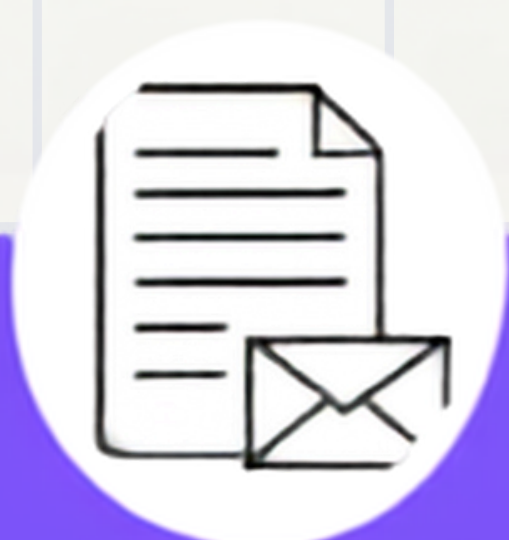
An initial session takes place during which the practitioner introduces themselves and the service. The young person has a chance to engage and confirm whether they would like to begin sessions.



### STEP 4: SESSIONS END

The sessions come to a planned and agreed-upon end.

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### STEP 1: REFERRAL RECEIVED

A referral is made. This could be a self-referral or made by a parent, carer, or member of staff. The referral is then processed by our admin team and reviewed for suitability to the service.

IMPORTANT: If under 13 yrs old, parent consent must be obtained prior to step 2.

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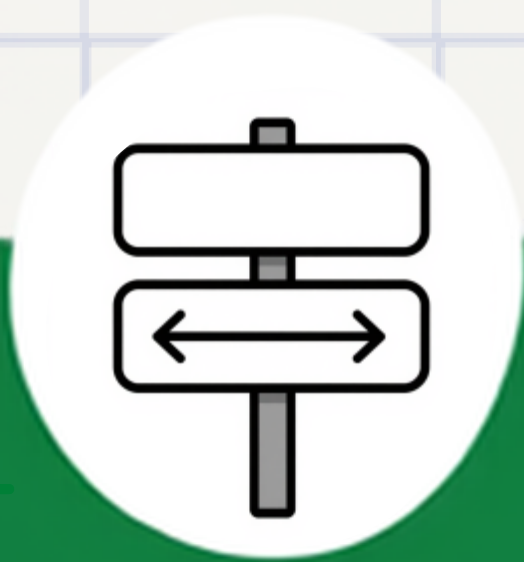


### STEP 3: SESSIONS BEGIN

We typically offer 8 sessions. Sessions are continually reviewed to ensure the young person is engaging and feels they are benefiting from the support provided.

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### STEP 5: CLOSING THE REFERRAL

Following our final session an ending letter is sent out to both the young person and referrer. (If under 13, a copy is also sent to the parent/carer)

Signposting for future support may also be discussed if this feels needed
